Multi-stakeholder consultation on Africa's Continental Free Trade Area—June 12-14, Accra, Ghana

Third World Network Africa hosts a 3-day multi-stakeholder consultation on Africa's Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) from June 12-14 in Accra, Ghana. The consultation is part of interventions by members of the Africa Trade Network (of which TWN-Africa is the secretariat) since the launch of the CFTA. Participants are drawn from across the continent and includes policy makers (government officials) from various Africa countries, the private sector, trade unions, women's groups, trade experts, civil society groups and representatives of regional economic communities.

The 3-day consultation aims to evaluate the framework agreement and adopt agenda for both national and regional work for engagement with the various processes towards the ratification of the CFTA and related issues.
